- We are an independent Members' Club, which is registered with the Lawn Tennis Association.
- We are a friendly Club with a wide standard of players, from those interested in serious match play to those happy with social doubles. The Club wishes to provide enjoyable play for Members of a reasonable Club standard but also caters for newcomers interested in improving with coaching, which is available and can be arranged with our Club Coach.
- The Club was founded in 1922. We have one club room attached to the church buildings however in the summer we use our summer house.
- We have 5 top quality artificial grass, all weather courts.
- The courts are available for play from Monday to Saturday from 8.30am to 10pm. On Sundays and Good Fridays play is permitted from 1.00pm to 5.30pm. The floodlights on courts 1 / 2 and 4 / 5 may be used up to 10.00pm on all days except Sunday.
- It is possible to book courts online. You will be given a username and password when you join.
- Tennis balls are provided by the Club throughout the year.
- Times are set aside for Social Club Play, which we consider one of the attractions at our Club.
- Tuesday & Thursday mornings from 9am to 11am, Wednesday evenings from 7pm to 9pm and Saturday afternoons from 1pm to 5pm. At all these sessions you just turn up.
- There is doubles tennis from 7pm to 9pm each Monday evening. This is for a maximum of eight players and you need to book online.
- Each month there is a ladies match practice and a separate mens match practice. Times will be given by email.
- The Club has at present 6 mens teams, 4 ladies teams, 2 vets teams and also 4 mixed doubles teams which all compete in local leagues. We also have Friendly Matches with local Clubs and arrange our own social tournaments and charity tennis days.
- The Club Rules request that all players wear white or coloured tennis clothing on court. Approved tennis shoes must be worn (not 'trainers' or other unsuitable sports footwear).
- Car parking is available outside the Club in Brockley Grove and when necessary in the Church car park.
- Mmembers may bring visitors to play at the club, (maximum of 3 sessions per visitor and a cost of £3 per visit).
- Members are eligible for the Wimbledon draw, although must also be British tennis club members and must opt into the draw each year.
