Coaching Category rules:

- Only tennis clothing either white or coloured may be worn on court
- The wearing of footwear specifically designed for tennis is compulsory at all times
- Coaching category members may bring visitors to play at the club, (maximum of 3 sessions per visitor and a cost of £3 per visit).
- Coaching category members are welcome to use the tennis courts at most times but may not use the courts at the following times; Tuesday and Thursday mornings 9am – 12 noon, Saturday afternoons 1pm – 5pm
- Play on Sundays for all membership categories is only allowed from 1pm – 5.30pm
- A joining fee will be required if a coaching category member transfers to full membership
- It is possible to book courts online
- Coaching category members are eligible for the Wimbledon draw, although must also be British tennis club members and must opt into the draw each year.
